The Truck Giving

We had been needing, praying, and fundraising for a truck for the mission here. We are always hesitant to ask, as people already give so much to help WISE. We did have some individuals and a few churches who gave. Thank you!

A truck here can be very expensive, since cars are imported. We had hoped to find a used truck to transport our growing student body in and for hauling work supplies. Our original plan of \$10,000 was just not going to buy a truck here. At this point, we still had not even raised half of that amount. And then we received word from 2 churches:

- “Our church has money saved up, and rather than just let it sit and accumulate, we would rather you used it for the truck you need and would use there.”

- “Our church is not able to start supporting WISE at this time, but we would like to help in giving you \$5,000 for your truck.”
